

## $1^{\text {st }}$ POWER4MED International Workshop Agenda

Jointly organised by the Univeristy of sciences and technology of Oran-USTO( theLaboratory of marine sciences and engineering-LSIM), SDG4MED and the EU WESTMED initiative and supported by the POWER4MED project, the workshop is chaired by Prof. Beladjine Boumediene and gathers authorities and experts from all over the Mediterranean to jointly define the Strategic Empowerment Agenda (SEA) for the Green Transition of the maritime sector.

The Mediterranean is facing a double challenge: restoring its health and ensure wealth to its increasing population. None of the two is more important of the other and they must be achieved jointly and synergically. This is well understood in common international instruments such as the Mediterranean Action Plan (agreed by all the Mediterranean Countries within the Barcelona Convention framework) and the FAO fishing policy.

Besides common policies, the transition to carbon neutrality requires short \& medium-term solutions for which several options are proposed, most of which are neither affordable nor yet fully available. Assessing all options, in line with the increasingly ambitious IMO targets is essential this is the objective of the POWER4MED project that focuses on the WESTMED region.
